Policy purpose

The purpose of this policy is to provide a framework for securing candidates for the national executive council and national committee chairs of the Editors' Association of Canada/Association canadienne des réviseurs.

Policy statement

The Editors' Association of Canada is committed to filling elected and appointed positions with high-quality candidates who have been through a nomination process.

Applicability

This policy applies to

- the national executive council
- the national nominating committee
- candidates for election to the national executive council
- candidates for appointment to national committee chair positions
- national committees
- members

Responsibility

The role of the national nominating committee is governed by section 5.08 of Bylaw No. 1 (2014).
