

Editors' Association of Canada/Association canadienne des réviseurs Volunteer Policy

Effective date: June 2021

Policy purpose

The purpose of this policy is to foster and support volunteer participation in the Editors' Association of Canada/Association canadienne des réviseurs.

Policy statement

Volunteers play a vital role in achieving the aims and objectives of the association, and are essential for the healthy functioning of the association. The Editors' Association of Canada (Editors Canada) supports volunteers and is committed to providing them with what they need to perform their roles effectively.

Applicability

This policy applies to all association members who volunteer for the association. That includes

- members who volunteer at the national, branch and twig levels of the association,
- members who serve on the national executive council, national committees, and branch and twig executives, and
- members doing a broad range of volunteer activities across the country.

Volunteer involvement is open only to members (as a benefit of membership). Exceptions to this are found in the *Volunteer Guidelines* document.

Responsibility

Volunteers are expected to

- commit to their volunteer assignments in good faith,
- perform their assignments in an effective and timely manner, and
- communicate respectfully and responsibly with other volunteers as needed.

The contributions of volunteers are regularly acknowledged by formal and informal recognition methods.

Volunteers are expected to seek guidance and feedback on their volunteer assignments, and are entitled to both.

Consequences for non-compliance with this policy can be found in the *Volunteer Guidelines* and Editors Canada's Bylaw No. 1 (2014), section 2.05 Discipline of Members.
