Editors' Association of Canada/Association canadienne des réviseurs Partnership Policy

Effective date: June 2021

Policy purpose

The purpose of this policy is to provide members of the Editors' Association of Canada/Association canadienne des réviseurs with opportunities to form partnerships with individuals, organizations and companies to the mutual benefit of the association and those individuals, organizations and companies.

Policy statement

The Editors' Association of Canada (Editors Canada) develops and fosters partnerships that support the aims, objectives and effectiveness of the association.

Definitions used within this policy

Partners are defined as individuals, organizations and companies that

- focus on writing, editing, publishing or other areas of communication, or
- provide products and services of value to the association and its members.

Partners may be based in Canada or elsewhere.

Applicability

This policy applies to the national, branch and twig levels of the association.

Responsibility

To establish, sustain and terminate partnerships requires the involvement of some or all of the national executive council, national office, national committees, branch executives and twig cochairs.

National-level partnerships

- In general, the national executive council is responsible for establishing all national-level partnerships.
- The national office is responsible for developing and managing all national-level partnerships.
- National committees are responsible for tasks assigned by the national executive council.

Branch- and twig-level partnerships

- In general, branch executives are responsible for branch-level partnerships and twig cochairs are responsible for twig-level partnerships.
- Branch executives and twig co-chairs are encouraged to look for opportunities to develop local partnerships into national partnerships where the association and all members may benefit from national partnerships.

This policy is issued under the authority of the members of the Editors' Association of Canada.
